# Hassans Environment Prize 2023

Cash prizes of up to £7000.

#### What is the Hassans' Environment Prize?

Hassans formed a Gibraltar purpose trust known as the Hassans Environmental Trust in 2019 to mark the firm's 80th anniversary.

The Trust bought £80,000 of Gibraltar Savings Bank Debentures and we are delighted to now be in a position to allocate the accrued interest from this investment to award up to two prizes to be used on environmental initiatives relating to Gibraltar.



#### What is the submission criteria?

The Prize is open to individuals, companies, charities or educational organisations based in Gibraltar who present a pitch for an environmental project that they will implement locally. We will award the Prize to fund innovative solutions, ideas and initiatives which contribute to at least one of the following in Gibraltar:

- Climate change mitigation
- Sustainable use and protection of water and marine resources
- Transition to a circular economy, waste prevention and recycling
- Pollution prevention and control
- Biodiversity conservation and nature resource conservation including protection of healthy ecosystems

#### How do I/we apply?

To be shortlisted for the opportunity to present your initiative, you must submit a pitch document marked for the attention of catherine.knock@hassans.gi. Your pitch must not exceed 1000 words and must explain how the prize money would contribute to your proposed initiative

## What is the deadline and what are the next stages if successful?

Submissions must be made by Friday 30th June 2023. We will then be shortlisting up to five initiatives to move to the presentation stage. If successful you will be invited to present your initiative to our Trustees on Thursday 6th July. The presentation must not be longer than 15 minutes. The winning initiatives will be announced the following day.



#### Anything else we need to know?

The prize must be used to fund the winning initiative and updates on the progress of the initiative must be provided on request. All shortlisted initiatives must agree to being showcased on social media and other local media channels. We will also request updates on the initiative's progress.
